It's Just Sex by Jeff Gould



It's Just Sex – A Comedy about Lust & Trust, written by LA based playwright **Jeff Gould**, is an acclaimed, award-winning comedy that was a runaway success in each of its initial professional productions in Los Angeles. First produced in the US in 2009, **the Rep's production will be an Australian premiere.**

It's Just Sex is **Jeff Gould's** second play. In the world premiere, it won the Artistic Achievement Award for best original production of the year. In a recent interview Jeff said he loves "writing about marriage and sex — two things I someday hope to be good at!"

It's Just Sex is a provocative comedy about the realities of modern marriage, sex, and relationships. It depicts the lives of three typical couples, each experiencing the trials and tribulations of married life, during one fateful evening.

Phil, (**James Whitrow**) a finance executive is caught having an affair by his family therapist wife Joan, (**Bronwyn Ruciak**); Kelly, (**Tess O'Flaherty**) an earthy masseuse is struggling to avoid the non-stop sexual advances of her forever-horny novelist husband Carl, (**Steve Parker**); Lisa, (**Sharon Pitardi**) is a controlling attorney with an uptight, computer-nerd husband Greg, (**Luke Budgen**). **Laura Antoniazzi** appears as Amanda.

With the kids away at camp, they gather for a routine cocktail party. But as the alcohol flows, party games are played and secrets, truths and resentments are revealed, culminating in a surprising development. The results are hysterically funny and captivating but then the characters must confront the resulting effects on their lives and marriages, and their views of honesty, monogamy and relationship. **It's just sex.....or is it?**



VALE Ian Maitland

Ian Maitland, life time member, actor, director, former board member and former President, died on the 5th April, aged 66.

Ian joined the Adelaide Repertory Theatre in the early 80's.

He was an actor and director and during that time was involved in almost all the Rep's productions. Elected to the Board of the Rep in 1984, he continued to be involved with the board until he retired due to ill health. In 1995 the Rep experienced difficulties with the management of its main asset The Arts Theatre. With help from the then Minister for the Arts and other industry members, Ian was instrumental in returning the theatre to financial viability.

Ian served two terms as president: 1996 -1999 and 2002 – 2004. He was awarded Life Membership in 2004.

He was respected by the entire amateur theatre community and will be sorely missed.



VALE Glenn Vallen

Glenn Vallen passed away peacefully on the 1st May aged just 59. Board member, actor, director and techie extraordinaire to whom we shall be forever grateful for amongst other things, upgrading our technology and setting up our data base of over 1,000 followers.

Glenn became involved with theatre at school where Rep stalwart Pam O'Grady was his drama teacher. He was renowned for his hilarious rendition of "The Hole in the Elephant's Bottom."

During his career in community theatre Glenn worked with Salisbury Theatre Co., Northern Light Theatre Co., Elizabeth Rep., La Mama, La Mama at the Q, Burnside Theatre, ACTAD, the Met., The Adelaide Rep., Matt Byrne Media and many others, in too many shows to list.

He was respected as a Director, Musical Director, Actor and Musician and has even worked back stage as well.


